PC Sheppard and PCSO Smyth presented a verbal and written report outlining recent Police Activity and Initiatives. Items of note:

New PC has joined the SNT

Increase in thefts from cars, officers are leafleting to prevent people leaving items on show.

Burglaries in the area are currently targeting Asian gold and the elderly.

Youths coming in on the train to cause ASB. Officers patrolling regularly

Anti-Social Parking being targeted around the area. Being given warnings before ticketing occurs. Covid has caused an increase in Mental Health referrals and Domestic Abuse. Officers very busy with this aspect currently.
